Jesper Kjaedegaard (65) has more than 40 years of maritime experience. He was the CEO of The Maersk Company Ltd until 2009, after which he spent 9 years as a Partner with Mercator Intl, a leading global maritime consultancy specializing in ports and vessel network planning. Parallel to being Partner at Mercator Intl he was Chairman/NED for a number of companies in Europe/Latin America and Asia.

He currently serves as a Non-Executive Board Director/Advisor for a number of both listed and privately owned transport related companies in Europe and the Middle East.

Jesper Kjaedegaard is also past President of the UK Chamber of Shipping and Chairman of Maritime UK.

Jesper Kjaedegaard holds a degree from Copenhagen's Commercial College, followed by a degree from the A.P.Moller Shipping Academy where he furthered his knowledge in supply chain, logistics and finance.
